Malaysian Food

ROTI CANAI is a type of flat bread usually served with dhal or other types of curry such as fish curry or chicken curry. They are crispy, buttery and flaky





SATAY may consist of diced or sliced chicken, beef, pork, and other meats. These are grilled or barbecued over a wood or charcoal fire, then served with various spicy seasonings.





CENDOL is a sweet, layered, iced dessert containing green worm-shaped jellies (made with either rice flour or green bean flour), coconut milk and a sugar syrup known as gula melaka, or palm sugar





NASI KANDAR originated from Penang, where it was originally transported by food-sellers with a "kandar" or a pole held over the shoulder. Nasi Kandar served with curries of various types and range of side dishes





ASSAM LAKSA is a traditional Malaysian fish-based sour noodle soup. The dish consists of rice noodles, shredded fish, and sliced vegetables, most commonly cucumber, onion, and lettuce.





NASI LEMAK consists of rice cooked in coconut milk that is traditionally served with anchovies, cucumbers, peanuts, and boiled eggs. The dish is rounded up with the addition of a spicy chili paste called sambal.

Water Rafting (Ulu Slim River)




